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Emerging Literacy Networks 2017/2018

Our first round of ten Emerging Literacy Networks took place between the 16th and 31st of August. It was great to see representation from 108 of our schools with 332 practitioners attending including class teachers, ASN teachers, school senior managers, Early Years Education Support Officers, Educational Psychologists, Occupational Therapists and Speech and Language Therapists.

The networks this session are designed to support both year 1 (new to Emerging Literacy) and year 2 (those who are returning to the networks for a second year) practitioners. Each network is designed around the support provided for class teachers, ASN teachers and school senior managers as outlined below.
